### Notes

1. Normal expenditure plus a small contingency is almost the same as the precept. There is a slight one off increase in salary to account for a one month clerk overlap, but the on-going salary costs have increased. It was agreed to run two defibrillator courses. If this was cut back to one, a further £350 could be saved.
2. **Triangle**  
This figure is an estimate and includes digging out and removing the soil, new soil and grass seed and buying three posts (£115 each – from a street furniture supplier). An allowance has also been included for installation. The posts could be omitted to save money. It does not include buying the tree.
3. **Gritter**  
Agreed at the meetings but not yet purchased.
4. **Ditch Clearance**  
There is an outstanding invoice for £125 to clear the ditch on Watery Lane. The Council may wish to consider whether any further contingency should be set aside for drainage/flooding.
5. **New Noticeboard**  
Appealing, rural style noticeboards are expensive and are in the range of £1,500 depending on the features (most likely to be slightly more rather than less). This size quoted would be big enough for both the village hall and the parish council to use. Alternatively, the existing could be repaired and painted.
